AUTHORIZATION FOR CREMATION AND DISPOSITION OF CREMATED REMAINS

Cremation is an irreversible and final process. Please read carefully before signing.

I/We, the undersigned, certify that I/we have the legal right to control disposition according to **RCW 68.50.160** and to authorize the cremation, processing and disposition of the remains of: _____ who died on: _____ (date) and whose date of Birth is: _____ and SSN: _____ - _____ - _____.

Washington RCW 68.50.160: "If the decedent has not made a prearrangement ... the duty of ... disposition of such remains devolves upon the following in the order named: (a) **the surviving spouse**, (b) **the surviving adult children of the decedent**, (c) **the surviving parents of the decedent**, (d) **the surviving siblings of the decedent**, (e) **a person acting as a representative of the decedent under the signed authorization of the decedent.**" If I/we are not the only legal next of kin, or not the legal next of kin, I/we have made all reasonable efforts to contact such persons without success and have no reason to believe they would object to the cremation.

CREMATION DISCLOSURE:

1. The Crematory will not cremate any human remains which contain any type of implanted mechanical or radioactive device. I/We hereby authorize the Crematory, its agents and associates, to remove any such devices prior to cremation and dispose of such items at its discretion.
2. I/We acknowledge that neither the Funeral Home nor the Crematory is responsible for removing any item of value from the remains of the deceased prior to the cremation process. I/We agree to hold harmless the Funeral Home and Crematory from any liability for the destruction or loss of such items.
3. I/We understand that due to the nature of cremation, items such as body prosthesis, dentures, dental work, jewelry, or other unnamed personal articles will be altered, damaged or destroyed. I/We authorize the Crematory to dispose of, donate or recycle the above mentioned articles, and any other non-combustible materials, in any lawful manner it may deem appropriate, and to use any remuneration at its discretion.

4. All reasonable and best efforts are used to completely remove all of the cremated remains from the chamber. However some minute particles may be left behind and incidental or inadvertent comingling of such particles is a possibility and I/we understand this fact.
5. I/We understand that this document does not contain a complete and detailed description of every aspect of the cremation process.
6. In the event the cremated remains of the Deceased remain unclaimed for a period of 30 days, the Funeral Home shall give written notice to me/us or the designated person(s) named. I/We agree that in the event the cremated remains of the Deceased are unclaimed for a period of 120 days after the date such notification is mailed, the Funeral Home is authorized and directed to dispose of the unclaimed cremated remains by any lawful manner it may deem appropriate.
7. I/We agree to indemnify, release and hold the Crematory, Funeral Home, their employees and owners, harmless from any liability, cost or expenses in connection with the cremation process as authorized herein.
